## INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Teams will take the test in Beaupre 100 (Division II in back rows, Division I in front rows) and non-team participants will take the test in Chafee 271. Students from the same school must sit as far apart as possible. While room permits, students should sit in every other row.
- 2. No earbuds or communication devices may be worn.
- 3. Do not begin test until told to do so. You will have one hour after the beginning of the test to complete it. When the whistle blows at that time, turn in your test.
- 4. Information on the front of the exam may be filled in before the test begins.
- 5. Fill in **all** the information on the front and print your name and the name of your school on the first page of the test as well. If you do not indicate which division you are in your test may be disqualified.
- 6. If you do not fill in your answers on the answer sheet, your test will not be graded.
- 7. Do not separate the answer sheet from the test.
- 8. Guessing is permitted but not encouraged. It is better to leave a question blank than enter a wrong answer, because <u>in case of a tie</u>, the student with fewer wrong answers will be judged the winner.
- 9. **Please try the tie-breaker.** The tie-breaker can only INCREASE your score.
- 10. You may leave when you finish and turn in your test.
- 11. To turn in your exam, find the sign with your school's name on it. (They will be in alphabetical order.) Place your exam **on** (not in) the envelope behind or beneath that sign.
