## INSTRUCTIONS

Please read these instructions to your students.

- Members of the teams should be in Beaupre 100. Those with no more than one year of chemistry are Division I; Students with more than one year of chemistry or AP chemistry are Division II. Division I should be seated at the front half of the room; Division II in the back half. Non-team participants should be in Chafee Auditorium 271.
- 2. Students from the same school should be seated as far from each other as possible.
- 3. No earbuds may be worn. No communications devices may be used.
- 4. Students must not begin taking the test until told to do so. They will have one hour after the beginning of the test to complete it. At that time, they must turn in their tests. (See 11.)
- 5. Students should fill in **all** the information on the front (This may be done while waiting for the test to begin.) and print their name on the first page of the test as well. If they do not indicate which division they are in, their test may be disqualified.

## 6. Students must <u>not</u> separate the answer sheet from the test.

7. Answers must be marked <u>on the answer sheet</u>. Only the answer sheet will be graded.

- Guessing is permitted but not encouraged. <u>In case of a tie</u>, the student with fewer wrong answers, <u>more blank answers</u>, will be judged to be the winner.
- 9. Students are requested to try the tie-breaker. It can only increase their score.
- 10. Students may leave when they finish and turn in their test.
- To turn in the exam, find the sign with your school's name on it. (They will be in alphabetical order.) Place your exam on (not in) the envelope behind that sign.
- 12. We will assemble at noon in Beaupre Center 100 for the awarding of prizes.
