
For this course you will be required to purchase McGraw-Hill Education Connect® access for Burdge, Chemistry: Atoms First 4e. You are not required to have a print text and please be aware if you purchase a used textbook you will still need to purchase Connect access.

Your least expensive options for purchasing the materials are from within your instructor's Connect account. When you log into Connect the first time, you will be prompted to set up an account for yourself and you will be given the choice of purchasing Connect access for Burdge for 1 semester (\$75) or for 4-semesters (\$110). You can use the 4-semester version for taking CHM 112, too.



This is much less expensive than the national price for Connect-only! Do not buy your Connect access from MHHE.COM or other sites....it will be more expensive than the special URI discounted price!

The bookstore is also carrying the following option that was created for you:

• **ISBN 9781264290260** = a bundle of the loose-leaf copy of the Burdge book + 4-semester Connect access = \$175.70. You can use financial aid in the bookstore. And again, because this includes 4-semester access, it is good for both CHM 101 and 112.

**Important**: You must register in Connect even if you haven't purchased your code yet. Connect offers **TEMPORARY ACCESS**, which is free access for approximately 2 weeks from the start of class so you don't fall behind with reading assignments. When you follow the registration steps outlined in the PowerPoint you will be given the option of selecting **TEMPORARY ACCESS**. Please do this if you haven't purchased your access code yet, as this will ensure that you don't fall behind in class assignments. (You can read the ebook and complete assignments with Courtesy Access).
